Hall Avenue (State Route 150) is an east-west arterial roadway and gateway to downtown Wallingford. As such, the Town wants to enhance this transportation route with landscape features that complement those in existence on Center Street and nearby Quinnipiac Avenue. This DOT administered project proposes streetscape elements along both sides of Hall Avenue including decorative street lights, street trees and decorative brick pavers within the space between the back of curb and sidewalk.

In addition to streetscape improvements to Hall Avenue the project will include a connective pedestrian trail from the Quinnipiac River Linear Trail at Community Park (west side of the Quinnipiac River) to the Town's Senior Center located off of Washington Street (Silk Street). This connection will use existing sidewalks along Hall Avenue and Washington Street (with improvements as needed) to Oak Street. At Oak Street, the connection "trail" will head west onto Oak Street to a point where it will the turn north and traverse Town of Wallingford property before reaching the Senior Center. The total length of improvements to Hall Avenue which include the addition ornamental lighting and street trees is approximately 2,700-feet.
