A new multi-purpose artificial turf field was installed to replace a heavily used natural turf field at the complex's main soccer venue. This will allow for more intense use by the various athletic programs while maintaining excellent field conditions throughout the year. Also included was repositioning the bleachers and expansion of the same – doubling the capacity.

Work included an analysis of subsurface conditions and the design of a drainage system to accommodate the new field as well as drainage improvements for all other improvements.

Just prior to the completion of construction the field was tested by the rainfall from Hurricane Irene. Needless to say the field performed as designed allowing construction to continue the next day.
