The Town of Ledyard, working through the Ledyard Town Center Committee, issued a Request for Proposals for professional planning, engineering and architectural firms to prepare a design development plan for improvements to the Town Fair Grounds located at 740 Colonel Ledyard Highway.

Ledyard desired to create, foster, and promote a vibrant town center. As part of that effort, enhancing the Town fairgrounds to create a town green identity was identified as a priority and a specific improvement list was developed. In 2008, a grant in the amount of \$150,000 was approved from the State of Connecticut to fund improvements to the fairgrounds.

The improvements consisted of the construction of a stone wall along the Town Green boundary adjacent to Connecticut Route No. 117 (Colonel Ledyard Highway), construct an enhanced playground that meets the requirements of the Ledyard Parks and Recreation Commission and applicable codes, plant trees and shrubs at the beginning of the town center at the intersection of Center Groton Road and Colonel Ledyard Highway to create a gateway to the Town Green, relocate facility utilities underground, install poles to hang banners to advertise community activities, preserve space to incorporate Ledyard Agricultural Fair activities, build a new stage / amphitheater and install drinking fountains.
