The development on the wooded fifteen acre site on Crow Hill by the Mohegan Tribe as its Tribal Government Center consists of the construction of an approximate 2,500 linear foot extension of Crow Hill Road, associated underground utilities, recreation fields, and the new Government Center building.

Preliminary construction on the site involved clearing of the gross area and coordination of utility relocations from within the building footprint. The mass grading effort for the site included relocation of approximately 30,000 cubic yards of previously stockpiled material, together with an additional 60,000 cubic yards of material from other ongoing construction activities. In addition to the building and roadway extension; large runs of underground utilities were constructed, including, 3,300 linear feet of gravity sanitary sewer, 3,500 linear feet of concrete encased duct bank for fiber optic, security, telephone and electric services, 1,200 linear feet of domestic water main, and 2,500 linear feet of gas line. An emergency ingress/egress point was provided by constructing a 1,000 linear feet of gravel road originating from the cul-de-sac on Sunny Hill Drive and 900 linear feet of gravel service road was connected to the terminus of Fort Shantok Road.

Along with the Government Center building, there are other tribal uses for the site were considered. A seventy-five by one hundred and fifty foot recreational pad was constructed off the west wing of the building. A covered pavilion is to be installed for outdoor activities and a storage shed is to be incorporated into the pavilion structure. Within the center of the entrance cul-de-sac a water feature and two flag poles are to be installed. An underground storage cistern was incorporated into the roof drain system to provide water for irrigation of the recreation field and landscaped areas around the Government Center building.
